A Polish Reflection on this week's Gospel

In today's gospel, Jesus speaks of perseverance in prayer. Perseverance that may seem senseless at times, as in the case of Abraham who prayed to save the people of Sodom. After all, didn't they deserve what was coming?

Or perseverance, which simply puts us in an embarrassing situation, such as the one described in the Gospel. Most of us would just respect our friend's privacy and give up quickly. But this would not build our characters. The Lord Jesus wants us to persist in our prayers and overcome our feelings so we are able to focus on something greater than us, on God who is Love.

Pan Jezus chce, abyśmy trwali w naszych modlitwach, byśmy przetrzymywali nasze uczucia i mogli skupić się na czymś większym od nas, na Bogu, który jest Miłością.
