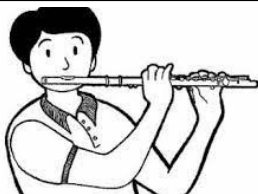
On Friday 10th March the Stations of the Cross will be lead by the Secular Branch of the Sacred Hearts Congregation directly after Mass.
