27th March. Feast day of Pierre Coudrin SS.CC.

The birth of the Congregation is rooted in the French Revolution. In March 1792, a Frenchman named Pierre Coudrin was secretly ordained to the priesthood. The following May, in the midst of a nation in turmoil turning against Catholic religious leaders, Fr Coudrin went into hiding. During his time in hiding, he had a vision in which he saw a band of missionaries—men and women—dedicated to spreading the Gospel everywhere. On Christmas Eve in 1800, knowing they could face the guillotine for their actions, Fr Coudrin along with his co-founder Henriette Aymer de Chevalerie officially established the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary and of Perpetual Adoration with a mission to spread the message of God's unconditional love as manifested through the Hearts of Jesus and Mary and finding God's mercy through the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
